What a Lesson Looks Like	
Sentence Accuracy and Essential Grammar Activity (apart from the first in a new unit when it is at the end of the lesson). KS2 only write the grammar focus under their title and highlight to make it easier to look back and refer to during the unit. Modelled example: Grammar focus highlighted/underlined in orange; capital letters/sentence punctuation highlighted/underlined in green.	
Vocabulary exploration (happens once he has been introduced as part of the second or third Immerse lesson)	
Essential Teaching (mixture of reading, drama or writing (incidental or final outcome) depending on the lesson type)
